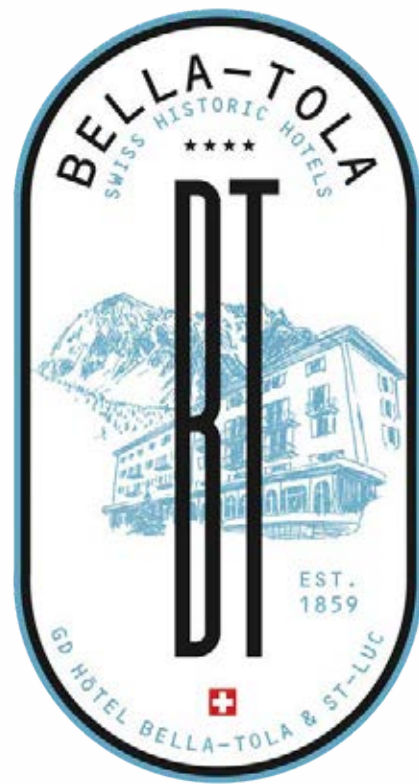

THE HOTEL

The Hotel Bella Tola dates from 1859, it was the first hotel in the Val d'Anniviers. It was first operated only during the summer season for English tourists and then also opened in winter with the arrival of ski lifts for the ski season. It was never closed, it has always been operated as a hotel. Pierre Pont was the founder of this hotel and then the hotel remained the property of this family for 4 generations until 1996, when the Buchs family took over the house.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

The bella tola hotel's mission is to perpetuate a fine example of alpine mountain hotels by offering guests a unique, timeless stay that only a historic hotel can offer. The hotel is a founder member of the Swiss Historic Hotels.

We place our guests at the heart of our concerns and we commit that our guests lives at the Bella Tola a unique emotional experience. We cultivate with our customers "a beautiful family spirit", many are regulars and operate as real ambassadors of our house.

Our quality culinary offer gives pride of place to seasonal and regional products thanks to a local supply. (Alpine cheese – goat and sheep cheese – fruit – cured meats – bread – wines only regional – Morret fruit juices)

We work for our renovations and works exclusively with companies in the region. (carpenter – plumber – plasterer – painter)

The atmosphere and the care given to the décor are the key words of the house. The constantly renewed floral decoration has asserted itself as the "signature" of the place. Interior decoration, planning and design of maintenance and renovation work are part of the passions shared by the couple of the house AFB and CB.

The hotel is an integral part of the village community and remains a mecca of cultural life.

ACTIVITIES

SUMMER SEASON

Since 1996 the hotel has become an essential meeting place as well as a driving force in the programming of the activities of our village. The flavor of a stay goes beyond a room and a meal, we consider the emotional experience as the key to a positive memory.

Every Tuesday morning: botanical walk with an herbalist
Every Monday evening: guided historical tour of the house

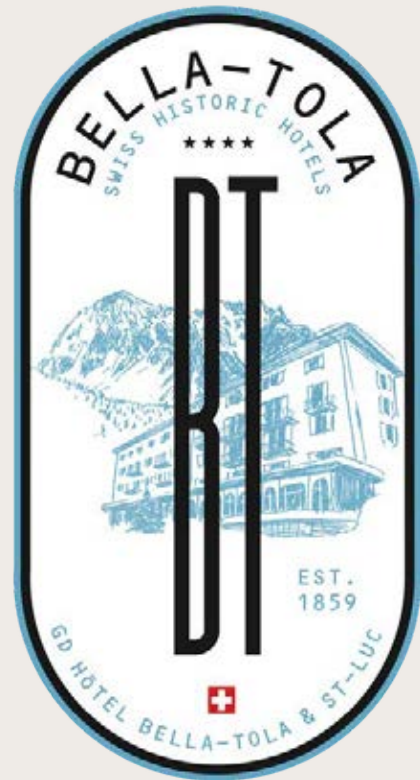
On specific dates: ornithological – mycological – geological – butterflies outing

THE RESIDENCES

The hotel has expanded since 2007 by 2 chalets alpine residences. These chalets are decorated in a completely alpine atmosphere, original period furniture, antique objects, animal skin.

Chalet du Chamois

Located in the village, 5 min. walk next to the church

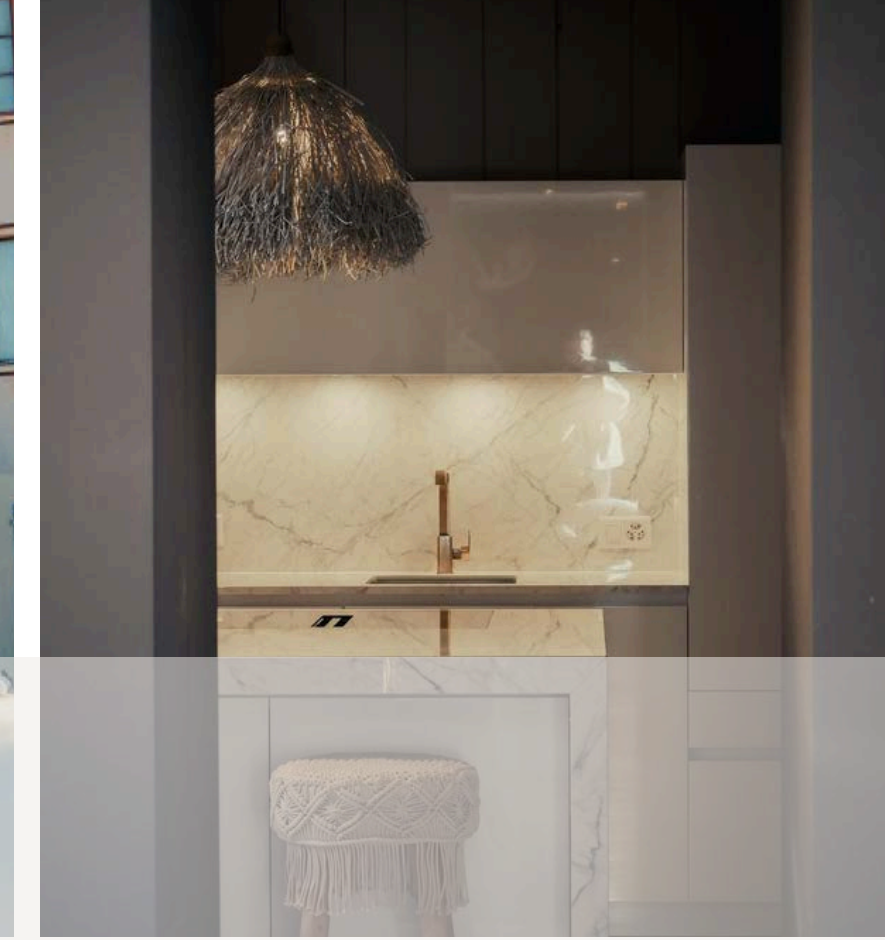
Cleaning service every 3 days

The Loft

Located on the 1st floor, this bright apartment offers a cocoon of softness.

2 double bedrooms, one with private shower and WC, kitchen, bath / WC, living room with fireplace and deck with breathtaking views of the mountains. Independent access and advantages of a historical hotel service at hand.



The Mayen

Located 1 h 15 walk from the hotel – Only in summer season

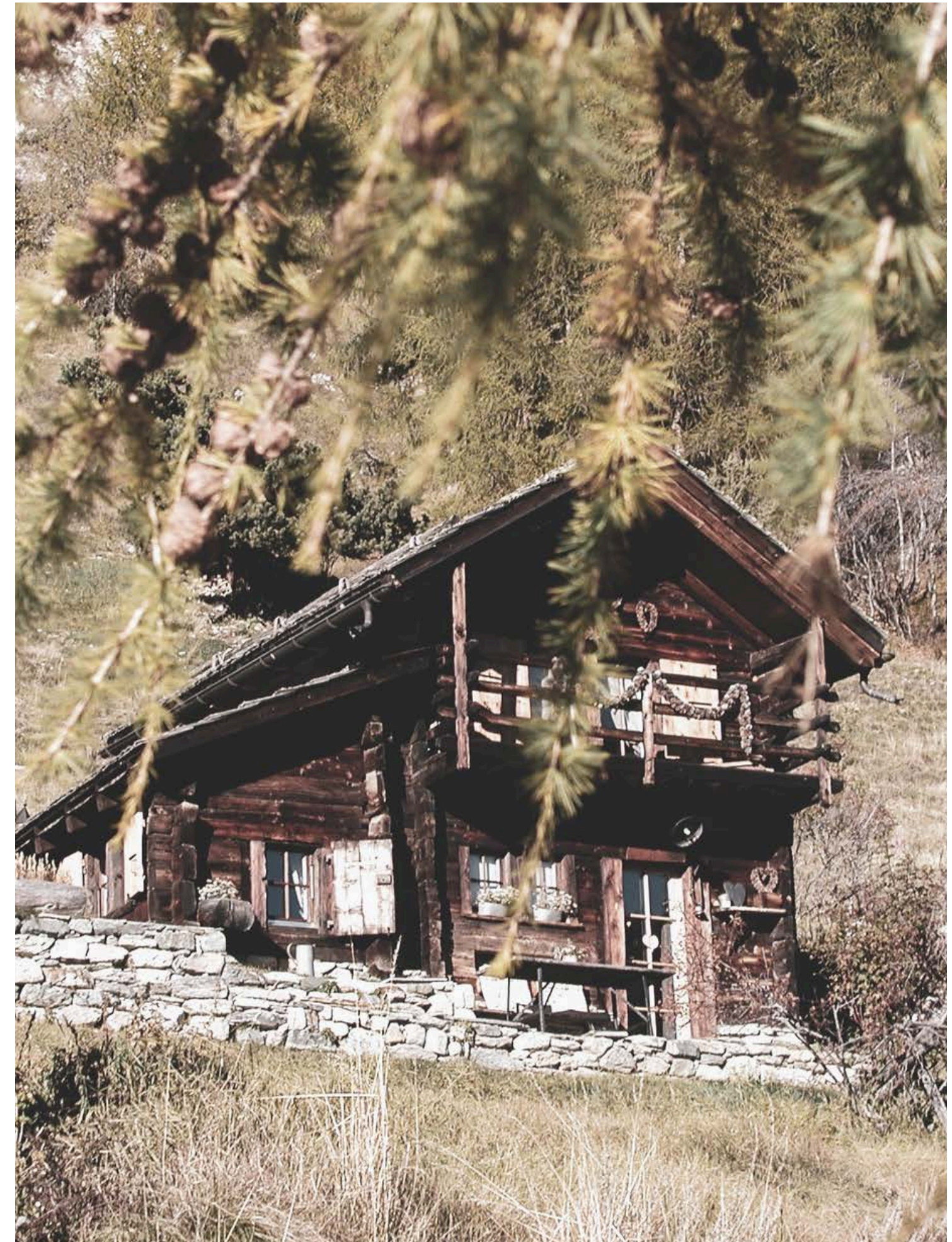
It is a dwelling used by the inhabitants of the village who went to the mayen with the cattle in mays. As the seasons went by, the inhabitants moved with the cattle up to the mayen, (this way of life is called the Stiring). This mayen is a sketchy old dwelling, built in old larch planks.

The reception of guests is done here at the hotel, then guests usually go up on foot (1 h 15), we meet at the Mayen for the welcome and explanations.

Provision of baskets of victuals, (baskets of cheeses of the country, dried meats, herb sausages, dry bacon, ham of the valley, fruits and vegetables of season) everything is installed on the arrival of our guests, every 2 days we bring back victuals according to the desires of the customers.

The guests of the mayen cook themselves, there is a small vegetable garden where they can pick aromatic herbs.

1 double bedroom, sitting area, shower / WC, equipped kitchen, running water, electricity, open wood fireplace, small plot around the mayen with deckchairs, magnificent view from the table that is in front of the Mayen.





THE "SALONS"

LThe Salons of the 1st floor

On the first floor of the house we have the living rooms in a row
Salon room 1900: Dining room that we call "Salon 1900" for
breakfasts with a beautiful terrace South facing.

Salon Vallet

Salon bearing the name of the famous Genevan painter Edouard
Vallet because many etchings adorn the walls of this salon, this salon
is also used for breakfast.

Salon Ravel

Small boudoir bearing the name of the painter Edouard Ravel, our
guests can play cards (approx. 5 seats)

The living rooms on the ground floor

Reception for a personalized welcome with table and armchairs to
welcome guests during check in. We always offer them a welcome
herbal tea.

Large central living room of the house with fireplace, very friendly,
with 2 levels, grand piano with pianists



RESTAURANT

Chez Ida

Restaurant "chez Ida": restaurant in the Veranda, "à la carte" restaurant, creative cuisine giving pride of place to seasonal products and fresh products, Southern touch insuflée by our Breton Cheffe Céline Guiheneuf - about 30 seats

"Library": same restaurant with orange velvet décor, also in a veranda facing the large maple tree.

13 points Gault and Millau

The Bar: located in the restaurant with 2 high tables for aperitifs





RESTAURANT

Le Tzambron

Restaurant "Le Tzambron": Valais restaurant where we serve regional specialties fondue, raclette, cheese crust - about 30 seats

Tzambron means "small room" in the dialect of the valley.



THE SPA

L'Ô des Cimes

This alpine retreat incorporates "L'Eau des Cimes" - our high altitude SPA, where the delights of nature are celebrated. In the choice of materials, noble and seductive, a juxtaposition of styles is on show: dark and limpid, pebble rugs, dressed stone walls, animal skin cushions, hunting trophies, anything and everything to feed the soul. Panoramic terraces facing the snow-capped, 4000m peaks extend the spa outside, for a total immersion in the natural surroundings.

THE SPA

The ground cement basin with its crystal clear water reveals, below, a glittering mosaic. Alongside, a crackling fireplace adds to the pure enchantment of the senses.

Facing the snow-capped summits of the Matterhorn or the Obergabelhorn, elegant reclining chairs invite you for a moment of farniente on the panoramic terrace, directing your attention to the natural and divine wonders of Mother Nature.

For massages:

Exclusive blend for "L'Ô des Cimes" of organic sesame oil + essential oils (different blends to choose from)

- Massage oil "Bois d'Anniviers" (essential oils arolle and pectin pine)
- "Special Frisson" massage oil (essential oils of clove, cedar, patchouli and cinnamon)

Our Signature treatment: **"Ritual of Anniviers"** (body peeling with marrow flowers, body packing with glacial mud, body massage with alpine flowers by picking plants on the alpine pasture by my husband and I, drying in our attic on the sheets and making homemade pouch. (see separate file of Ritual of Anniviers)

For anti-aging facials we also work with the **Alpeor** line (we are the first Alpeor Spain Switzerland). It is a Swiss brand that grows plants in the Val de Bagnes and the manufacturing is also in Vouvry in Valais. (very good brand, accessible at the price level).

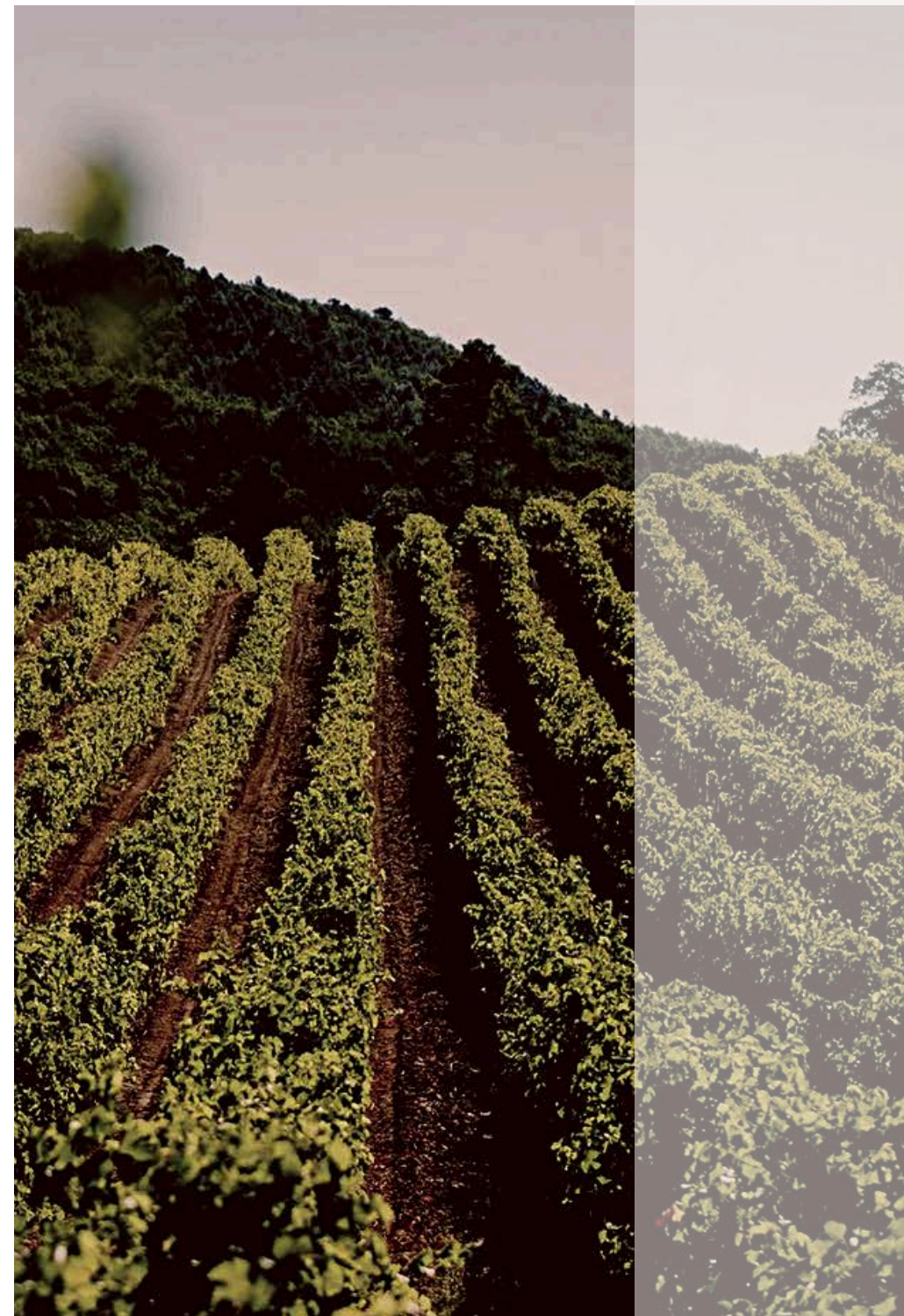
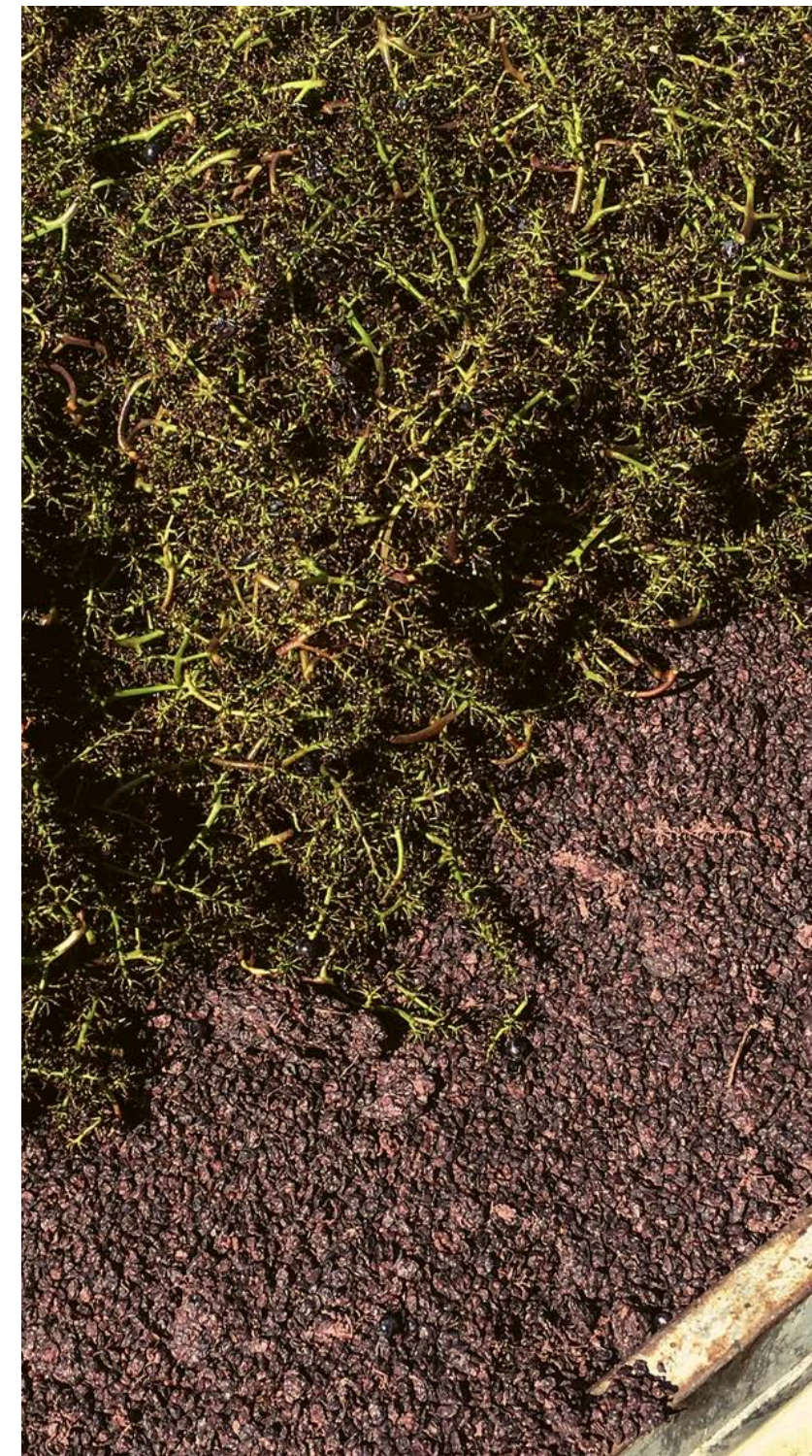

LATEST RENOVATIONS

2004-2005 New spa and ground floor rehabilitation

2008 New car park behind the hotel

2009 New decoration of the dining room

2010 Renovation of 4 bedrooms on the 2nd floor

In June 2011 we completed the renovation of the 4th floor. We have thoroughly redone 7 rooms as well as the corridor.

This work focused on:

3 small rooms have been redesigned, we have transformed them into 1 superior double room and 1 Junior Suite.

4 bedrooms have kept the same size.

Sound and thermic insulation, fire doors, new windows, water inflow, sanitary

Plaster has been banned, walls have been smoothed and wallpapers have regained their former place, sanded arolla pine floors.

Freestanding bathtubs, nickel faucets, maintenance of original sinks, old objects or also replicas of old ones.

Totally individualized decoration with authentic objects (lamps, switch, furniture).

2013 Resumption of the Grand chalet Favre in the heart of the village with 15 rooms

2004-2005 New spa and ground floor rehabilitation

2014 renovation floors – façade at Gd Chalet Favre

Le Gd Chalet Favre



THE GD CHALET FAVRE

Village guesthouse built in 1933 by Anselm Favre. Fief of the local societies, like the ski club and the inhabitants of the village, it remains their home base.

The second generation with Gérard and Marie-Paule Favre will save it to be finally taken over by the Buchs family in 2013.

The idea was to create a different offer from the Bella Tola with a mountain spirit where it is good to live in simplicity. This charming authentic chalet is nestled in the heart of the village and houses 15 charming rooms individually renovated by A.-F. Buchs.

Those facing the valley all have a small balcony or beautiful terraces on the first floor.





The restaurant, which is bathed in light, is also permanently dynamic, with the decoration and the menu changing with the times. Velvet benches and antique chairs with the wardrobes of bourgeois families are in perfect harmony.

Chef Youri Sluse skilfully handles authentic flavours with more oriental fragrances. Raclette with Anniviers cheese is served every Monday evening. Gérard's famous homemade cordon bleu and blueberry pie are among the must-tries.

In the living room, fireplace all in arole, magnificent low reliefs representing the peasant life, (executed by André Pont) play the first roles. The old-fashioned black piano, the comfortable cane armchairs and the velvet meridian seats in monochrome tones are all elements that invite you to enjoy the good life.

A detour to the terrace is a must, here time stands still in front of the splendor of the snowy peaks. Spectacular view on the Matterhorn, Obergabelhorn, Besso and Zinalrothorn.

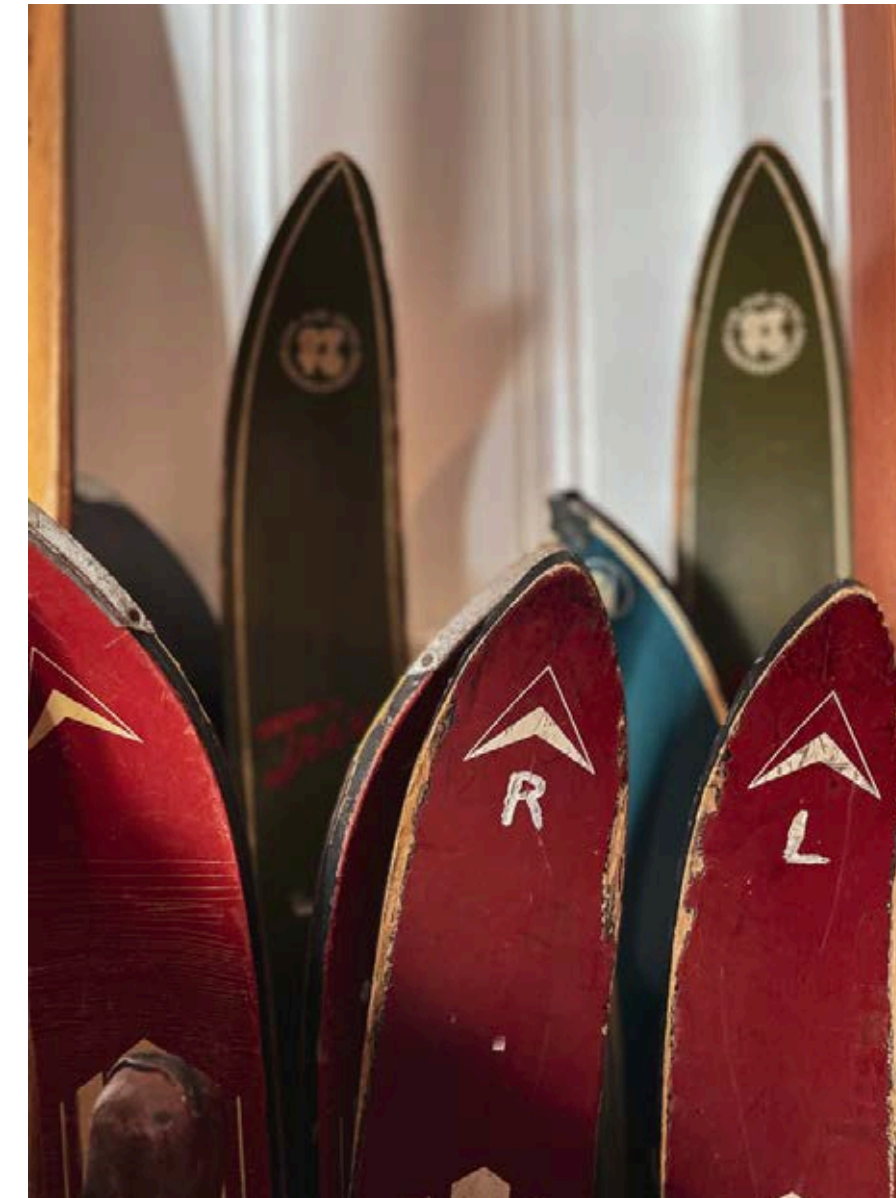
LE GD CHALET FAVRE

Pension villageoise construite en 1933 par Anselm Favre.

Fief des sociétés locales, comme le ski club et des habitants du village, ils restent leur port d'attache.

La deuxième génération avec Gérard et Marie-Paule Favre s'en sépareront pour finalement être repris par la famille Buchs en 2013.

Il s'agissait de créer une offre différente du Bella Tola avec un esprit montagnard où il fait bon vivre en toute simplicité. Ce charmant chalet authentique est lové au cœur du village et abrite 15 charmantes chambres rénovées individuellement par A.-F. Buchs. Celles orientées côté vallée ont toutes un petit balcon ou également de belles terrasses au 1er étage.





Le restaurant baigné de lumière affiche aussi un dynamisme permanent où la décoration ainsi que la carte des mets évoluent au fil du temps. Banquette de velours et chaises anciennes arborant les armoires des familles bourgeoises se côtoient en parfaite symbiose.

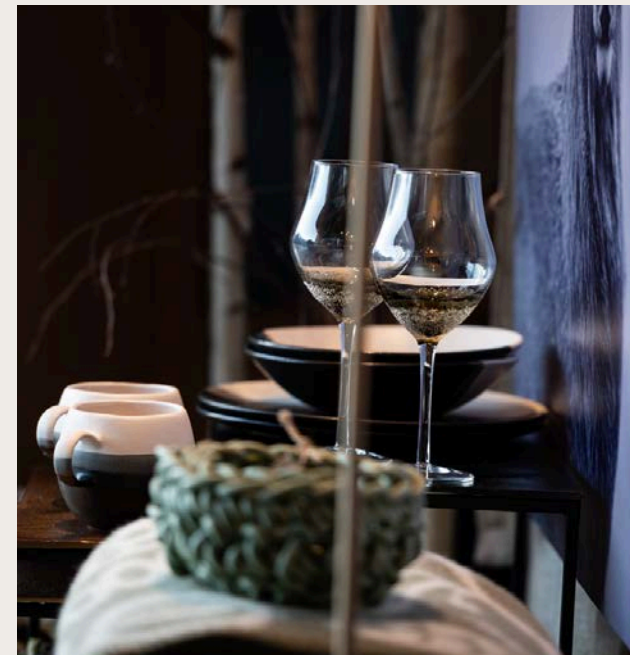
Le chef Youri Sluse manie habilement les saveurs authentiques aux effluves plus orientales. La raclette au fromage d'Anniviers y est servie tous les lundis soirs. Le fameux cordon bleu maison de Gérard et la tarte aux myrtilles font partie des incontournables.

Dans le salon cheminée tout en arole, de magnifiques bas-reliefs représentant la vie paysanne, (exécutés par André Pont) jouent les premiers rôles. Piano noir désuet, fauteuils confortables en cannage et méridiennes de velours aux tons camaïeux sont autant d'éléments invitant à la douceur de vivre.

Un détour sur la terrasse est obligé, ici le temps s'arrête face à la splendeur des cimes enneigées. Vue spectaculaire sur le Cervin, Obergabelhorn, Besso et Zinalrothorn.
